CAMPAIGN FOR ZERO A SUCCESS! NO HEALTHY ANIMALS EUTHANIZED IN DULUTH SHELTERS IN 2010

IN 2010, DULUTH REACHED TWO MAJOR MILESTONES IN ANIMAL SHELTERING:

- **Zero euthanasia of healthy homeless animals** at either Duluth shelter; and
- **93% live release rate** for all animals that entered either shelter.

Without precedent in a major Minnesota city, these accomplishments put Duluth next to three other communities in the United States — Reno, Nevada; Charlottesville, Virginia and Ithaca, New York — as the safest cities in the nation for homeless pets.

This momentous progress is the result of the Campaign for Zero – a partnership of Animal Allies Humane Society, the City of Duluth, Northland Spay/Neuter Clinic PLLC, maurices, and all Duluth animal lovers.

THE CAMPAIGN FOR ZERO SUCCEEDED BY:

- Placing 2,015 previously homeless cats and dogs into loving homes.
- Reaching more than 5,200 children and adults with humane education programs that teach respect, responsibility and kindness.
- Reducing pet overpopulation by making possible the spaying and neutering of more than 6,500 animals at the state's first spay/neuter clinic.
- Community members donating 15,135 hours of time through volunteering.

Zero euthanasia of healthy pets in our community would not have been possible without our partners in the Campaign for Zero.

- **maurices, our presenting sponsor**, made pet adoptions more affordable and galvanized community support for the campaign.
- **Northland Spay/Neuter Clinic PLLC** helped prevent unwanted litters by providing low cost, high-quality spay/neuter services to shelters and low-income households.
- **The City of Duluth Animal Control** educated the community about responsible animal care, enforced Duluth's progressive animal control laws, rescued pets from cruelty situations, reunited lost pets with their owner, and funneled unclaimed pets to AAHS for adoption.
- **YOU**, the animal lovers in our communities, who adopted, advocated, volunteered, donated, micro-chipped, licensed, and spayed/neutered like never before.

We still need your help to save all healthy animals again in 2011 and to make further progress toward our ultimate goal of saving all the treatable animals. Your efforts in the past year prove it can be done, and with your help and determination, we can attain this goal!

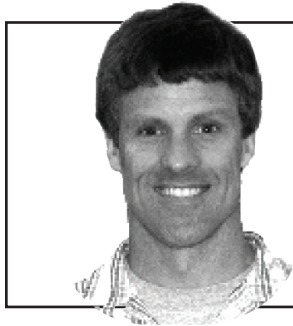

THE WORK OF HELPING VULNERABLE ANIMALS STARTS ANEW IN 2011

For Duluth-area animal lovers, December 31, 2010, was a day mixed of triumph and tragedy:

- **Triumph** because our community had saved every healthy homeless animal in 2010, a lifesaving milestone that forever raises the bar for what animal shelters can achieve throughout Minnesota;
- **Tragedy** because we learned that same day of 45 pets rescued from a hoarding case who would enter Duluth shelters in the first days of 2011 in need of immediate intensive attention.

For the volunteers and staff of Animal Allies, the hoarding cases were a painful reminder that the work of helping vulnerable animals is never done. Even as we rightly celebrate the landmark successes of 2010, we must be prepared for continued hard work. After all, Animal Allies' ultimate goal is not to save all of the healthy animals for just one year; it is to save all of the healthy animals (and, eventually, all of the treatable animals) *every* year.

As I write, I am looking at Grizz, a handsome 3 year-old miniature poodle, from one of the hoarding cases. Grizz will eventually be a healthy and happy family pet but, between now and then, he needs a lot of help. In the coming weeks, Grizz will need:

- Dental surgery by the Animal Allies medical care team to repair the extensive tooth decay typical of pets in hoarding cases;
- Socialization by Animal Allies volunteers to alleviate the fear of people pets develop living in crowded conditions with little human contact;

- Daily walks and attention from Animal Allies volunteers to keep Grizz happy and healthy while he awaits adoption; and
- Adoption counseling to find a compatible adopter with the patience to help Grizz work through his fears.

All of this work depends on you – your donations, volunteer service, and advocacy are what will shepherd Grizz to his new forever home. And what is true of Grizz is true of all the nearly 3000 homeless animals we expect to serve in 2011. They depend on all of us to relieve their suffering and ease their passage to a new forever home.

The work starts anew in 2011 and we will need your support and assistance every step of the way.

Thank you for your important role in making Duluth a model humane community for the state and the nation.

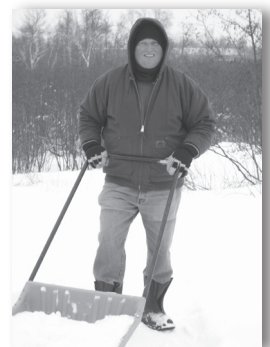

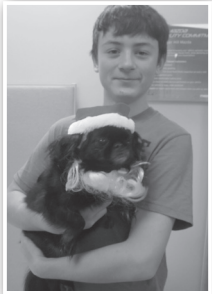

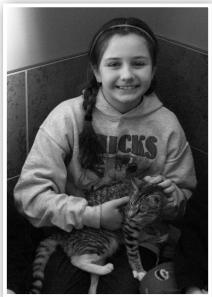

HOW CAN YOU MAKE A GIFT TO ANIMAL ALLIES WITH HELP FROM UNCLE SAM?

TAX TIP

Many contributors to Animal Allies have found that the form of their gift can facilitate the maximum tax advantage of the gift.

A cash gift is the simplest and most convenient means of sharing in the joy of giving. Cash allows you to write a check whenever you can afford it. Cash gifts qualify as a charitable contribution for federal income tax purposes and are fully deductible up to 50% of your adjustable gross income in the year you make the gift.

Gifts of appreciated securities, stocks or bonds may also be used as a means of contribution. By transferring the stocks or bonds to the Animal Allies, you may completely avoid capital gains tax, while securing a tax deduction for the full fair market value of the gift of securities equaling up to 30% of your income in the year of the gift.
